Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service will also provide and install a free 10-year smoke alarm or carbon monoxide alarm, if necessary. They will give life-saving advice in the event of a fire in your home and help to make a fire escape plan for you and your family. They will also provide advice on identifying fire hazards in the home.

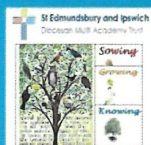

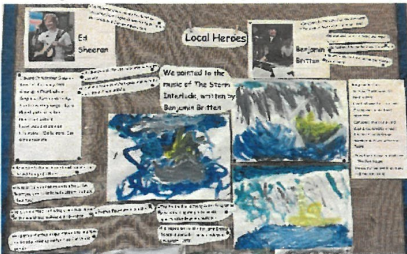
## Monthly Newsletter for June Bedfield CE Primary School

### Science Trips

Oak Class children were lucky enough to be invited to attend a 'K'nex Earthquake Challenge' workshop at Woodbridge School. ### Maple Class



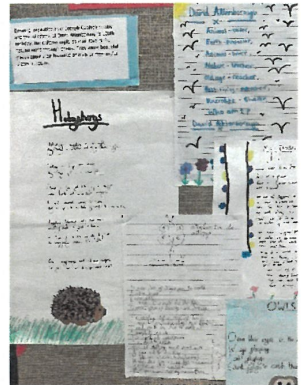

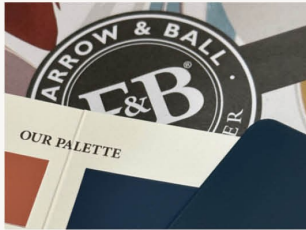


